Directions to the Couple and Family Therapy Center

From the North:

Take I-81 S toward Syracuse; Take the SALINA ST exit (19) toward CLINTON ST; Turn SLIGHT LEFT to take the SALINA ST ramp; Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto N SALINA ST; Turn LEFT onto JAMES ST/NY-5; Turn RIGHT onto OSWEGO BLVD/RT-5; Turn slight LEFT onto ERIE BLVD E/RT-5; Take first RIGHT onto S STATE ST/US-11; Turn LEFT onto E. GENESEE ST/RT-92; 601 E GENESEE ST is on the LEFT.

From the South:

Take I-81 N toward SYRACUSE; Take the ADAMS ST exit 18 toward HARRISTON ST; Turn slight RIGHT onto ALMOND ST; Turn LEFT onto E GENESEE ST/RT-92 W; 601 E GENESEE ST is on the RIGHT.

From the East:

Take I-690 W toward SYRACUSE; Take the TOWNSEND ST exit 13 toward DOWNTOWN; Turn LEFT onto N TOWNSEND ST; Take the first LEFT onto ERIE BLVD E/RT-5; Take first RIGHT onto S MCBRIDE ST; Turn LEFT onto E GENESEE ST/RT-92; 601 E GENESEE ST is on the LEFT.

From the West:

Take NYS Route 5 E to I-695 N; Merge onto I-690 E; Take W GENESEE ST exit 12 toward DOWNTOWN; Turn LEFT onto W GENESEE ST/RT-5; Turn RIGHT onto OSWEGO BLVD/RT-5; Turn slight LEFT onto ERIE BLVD E/RT-5; Take the first RIGHT onto S STATE ST/US-11; Turn LEFT onto E GENESEE ST/RT-92; 601 E GENESEE ST is on the LEFT.

To access services:

If you are interested in services, the first step is calling the clinic at (315) 443-3023 to complete an intake via phone. Once complete, a supervisor will contact you to discuss your needs in more detail and assign a therapist to your case. The therapist will contact you directly to schedule a mutually convenient appointment, usually within three weeks.
