Maximum number of credits allowed for transfer from any combination of 2 year schools is 66 credits. Maximum number of 90 credits may be transferred (if degree applicable), to include 2 and 4 year schools, AP credits, IB credits, etc.

Minimum grade allowed to transfer credit back to SU is a grade of "C". "C-" grades do not transfer.

It is the student's responsibility to request that an official transcript be sent directly to their college recorder upon completion of their course(s) taken at other institutions.
